Are you participating in SCRIP? What is SCRIP? Simply stated, it is using store gift certificates (the same gift cards you would buy if you went to a participating retailer) instead of cash or check. A percentage of each purchase is donated back to the program. These cards could be purchased to use for your everyday activities such as groceries and gas purchases. Use SCRIP instead of money to cut tuition costs and support school programs without spending a penny more than you normally would. SCRIP proceeds can be used for tuition assistance!
