ORIENTATION NIGHT:

CLCA is excited to host our annual Orientation Night. Below are the times for the following campuses:

- Early Childhood Program: 2 year olds - 4K is Tuesday, August 16, at the Bethany Building starting at 630**
- K-8 on Wednesday, August 17, at the Berea Campus starting at 6:30.**

The goal for these evenings are to inform and prepare you for the 22-23 academic year. Multiple sessions will be offered to visit classrooms for homeroom orientation. At the Berea Campus, CLCA will be hosting a session to allow families to meet with departmentalized (math, science, ELA, social studies) and speciality instructors (P.E., music, art, Spanish, Piano, Bad) for shorter orientation sessions. CLCA will also be hosting our registration during these events. This time will provide you the opportunity to speak with our Administration Team to review the TADS agreement, submit the Auxiliary Form, and ask any other pertinent questions.

BACK-TO-SCHOOL ASSESSMENTS:

Before the academic year officially begins, CLCA will be hosting back-to-school assessment sessions for all incoming students in grades 5K-8 at the Berea Campus. During these sessions, homeroom teachers will meet with each scholar to assess their academic strengths. Doing so prior to the start of the academic year will help our team develop and plan instruction that will meet your scholar's individual learning needs. **Back-to-school assessment sessions will be held at CLCA from August 8- 11.** Each session will take no more than 45 minutes, and scholars of the same family may be assessed simultaneously. SCRIP:

Additional tuition scholarship funds are available by using SCRIP. What is SCRIP? Simply stated, it is using store gift certificates or online forms (the same gift cards you would buy if you went to a participating retailer) instead of cash or check. A percentage of each purchase is donated back to your family's tuition account and CLCA! These cards could be purchased to use for your everyday activities such as groceries and gas purchases. Use SCRIP instead of money without spending a penny more than you normally would. **The average rebate was \$200. NEW HOT LUNCH PLATFORM:

CLCA will be operating a new online platform for our hot lunch program. School EZ will be used during the 22-23 academic year. All lunch orders must be placed a week in advance in order for our hot lunch provider to properly plan. More information will be provided at our annual orientation night.

BRIGHTWHEEL SYSTEM:

CLCA will be implementing a new online Early Childhood (toddler-4K) tuition and check-in system called BrightWheel. This system will allow for more efficiency and fluid communication from the ECE staff. More information will be provided at the ECE Orientation Night on Tuesday, August 16.

TADS ACCOUNTS:

TADS, our online tuition payment vendor, has recently sent out the access link to establish your 22-23 agreement. Please complete your agreement no later than **July 31, 2021**. Mrs. Heageny, our Office Manager, is available to assist you in any capacity.

AUXILIARY FORM:

The 22-23 Auxiliary Fee worksheet is available to determine the estimated fees that your family will be responsible for throughout the year. We ask that you submit the form at our annual Orientation event. You may submit this form to our main office. Please be aware that you are able to include these fees on your TADS agreement.
