SCRIP:

Additional tuition scholarship funds are available by using SCRIP. What is SCRIP? Simply stated, it is using store gift certificates or online forms (the same gift cards you would buy if you went to a participating retailer) instead of cash or check. A percentage of each purchase is donated back to your family's tuition account and CLCA! These cards could be purchased to use for your everyday activities such as groceries and gas purchases. Use SCRIP instead of money without spending a penny more than you normally would. The average rebate was \$200. Our highest rebate was \$1,200! TADS ACCOUNT:

TADS, our online tuition payment vendor, has recently sent out the access link to establish your family's 25–26 agreement. Please complete your agreement no later than **July 31**, **2025**. Families of 5K–8th grade students paying full tuition are eligible for a **3% discount** if tuition is paid in full by **August 20**.If you have any questions or need assistance, Mrs. Heageny is happy to help.
